

THE UKIAH BIBLE CHURCH VISION

Part 1: A church where unsaved people of every race can come to hear the clearly taught Word of God which will lead them to receiving Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. A church where old natures and personal habits are abandoned and replaced by the excitement of a new nature, wrought by God, and encouraged by involvement with God's people.

Part 3: A church where a whole culture of faithful believers are continually being developed through the building blocks of strong Christian families. Part 5: A regional church located on multiple acres of fully developed property, serving the entire Ukiah valley with the Gospel ministry, having a Worship Center, a Learning Center containing a Bible Institute, and a Life Center offering a vital and practical ministry to God's people with a connection to the community through sports, music and other ministries.
